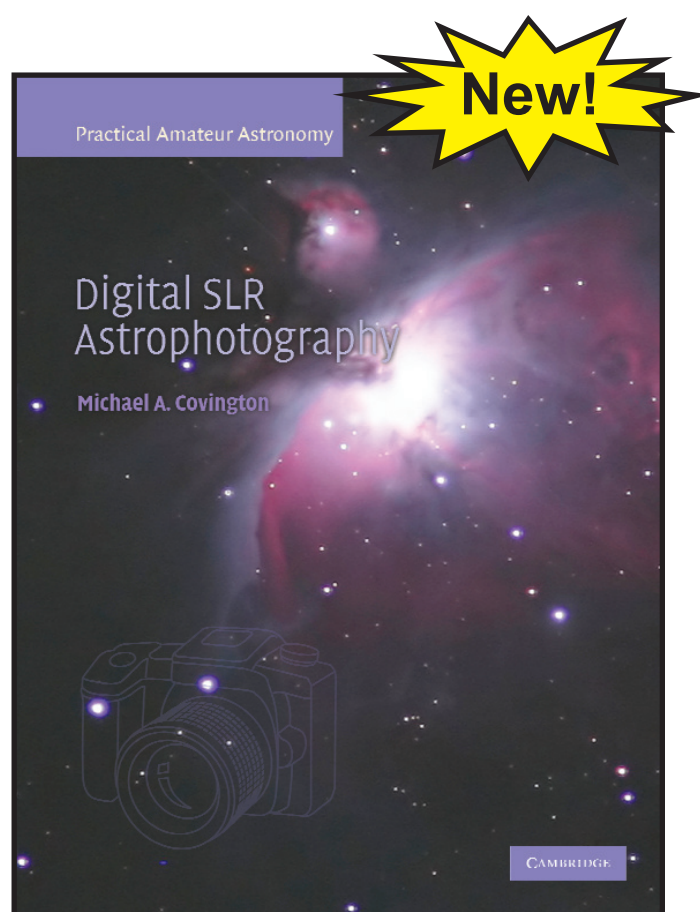


Digital SLR Astrophotography
