 Nothing to do with "apologizing" or being ashamed of our faith

Quite the opposite!

• Greek *apologia* = "defense"

As in "The Apology of Socrates"

1 Peter 3:15

"Always be prepared to make a defense (apologia) to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you..."

This is not optional.

If God has given you a brain and an education, He expects you to use them.

It's not enough to just use the Bible as a storybook and leave the hard questions to someone else.

What apologetics cannot do:

- Make people put their faith in Christ
 - Only the Holy Spirit can do that!

- "Prove" the claims of Christ (or anything else) to people who have made up their minds not to believe them
 - You can't "prove" anything to a totally closed mind.

What apologetics can do:

Show that Christian faith is rational

 Clear away objections, prejudices, and misconceptions

Remove obstacles (stumblingblocks)
